- 18 december 2018: draft report of the rapporteur:
 - Supports the harmonisation of the control rules among Member States;
 - Proposes several complementary elements, such as a designation of a unique administrative body in each Member State to coordinate the implementation of fisheries control, and a unique electronic inspection form across the EU.

As regards the necessary simplification of the control system, proposes measures to make it more accessible, among which a simple tool developed by the EFCA that would allow fishermen to have real-time access to the rules concerning them, and unique declaration forms in all Member States.



- opposes the limited introduction of a closed-circuit television (CCTV) on fishing vessels for surveillance of conforming to the landing obligation.
- Other amendments bring new elements on control rules for aquaculture and recreational fisheries.

Just to know...

- 18 june 2018: preliminary exchange on the new EMFF by the Agriculture and Fisheries Council EP Committee on Fisheries (PECH):
- 20 June 2018: public hearing on the issues and challenges encountered during the current EMFF and how to avoid them while implementing the new EMFF. First exchange of views on the newly proposed EMFF.
- 29 August 2018: second exchange of views.
- ◆ 4 September 2018: Draft report of the rapporteur → proposes to keep the same level of funding as the current EMFF and proposes to allow explicitly all measures supporting the four priorities that do not belong to the list of ineligible operations. Some other proposed modifications concern permanent and temporary cessation (seen as too prescriptive and rigid in the Commission proposal), the outermost regions (e.g. to allow support for the renewal of the traditional fleets), the processing and marketing of fishery and aquaculture products (e.g. to continue certain common rules) and support for producer organisation (e.g. the continuation of support for temporary storage).

945 amendments have been submitted, which have been considered in the PECH committee meeting of 27 November 2018.

The committee vote is scheduled for the meeting of 19 February 2019.???

A november 2018: opinion of the BUDG committee propose to reinforce the EMFF in accordance with its new mission on the blue economy. Concretely, the Parliament is proposing an increase of 10% as compared to the current EMFF (in 2018 prices, excluding the UK). In terms of current prices, this translates into a budget of €7 739 million for 2021-2027, an increase of 26% as compared to the Commission proposal.


