Subject: Landing Obligation in the Mediterranean Sea

Dear Mr Buonfiglio,

Further to the Seminar on the Landing Obligation of 24 February held in Brussels and to your letter of 1st of March (Ref. Ares(2016)1174615), I am writing to you today with the intention of facilitating the work of the Mediterranean Advisory Council on the application of article 15, paragraphs 1 and 5, of the Common Fisheries Policy.

As you are aware, the landing obligation for the species which define the fisheries will enter into force as from 1 January 2017. For the Mediterranean Sea, the species that are subject to this provision are those with minimum conservation reference sizes as defined in Annex III to Regulation (EC) No 1967/2006 (the "Mediterranean Regulation"). Among the aforementioned species, MEDAC and Member States may identify which of them can be considered as defining or driving the fisheries and therefore subject to the landing obligation as from 1 January 2017. The recent work of the Scientific, Technical and Economic Committee for Fisheries (STECF) on the landing obligation in the Mediterranean Sea¹ could serve as the basis for identifying and selecting species to include in the discard plans for 2017.

As from January 2019, the landing obligation will apply to all catches of (target and non-target) species in Annex III of the "Mediterranean Regulation", including the fisheries targeting species other than the ones defined in the abovementioned annex.

The STECF also examined whether disproportionate costs of handling unwanted catches may appear when implementing the landing obligation in the Mediterranean Sea. For this purpose, several indicators were identified and the profitability of certain fleet segments was modelled (see chapter "Identification of potential discard issues"¹).
