#### Maritime Spatial Planning: Directive (2014/89/EU), 20 plans adopted out of 22



EU support: 30 regional and cross-border **projects** – EUR 40+ million (EMFAF)

MS experts group, knowledge sharing: <u>EU MSP platform</u> – European Blue Forum for sea users – Compendium of multiple uses at sea, international cooperation with IOC UNESCO

Ocean Pact and MSP: 30% marine protected areas by 2030, 88 GW offshore wind, co-existence with fishing

- Maritime cooperation in upcoming new Strategic and Comprehensive Partnerships with partner countries in North-Africa and the Middle East




### Strengthening EU ocean diplomacy and international rules-based governance.

- Conservation and Sustainable Use of Marine Biological Diversity of Areas beyond National Jurisdiction (BBNJ Agreement): Swift ratification and implementation; EUR40 million contribution to the Global Ocean Programme
- Piloting of an International Platform for Ocean Sustainability (IPOS)
- Championing protected zones in Southern Ocean
- World Trade Organisation Agreement on Fisheries Subsidies: Entry into force and implementation
- Mandatory use of the digitalised (IT CATCH)
   EU catch certification scheme from January 2026
- Strategic approach to EU fisheries external action



### Guiding principles for implementation



#### Strengthened Governance Framework

Ocean Act: by 2026 that will build on a revision of the MSP Directive

Ocean Board: stakeholders supporting the Commission in implementation

Ocean Pact dashboard: to monitor and report progress

Implementation dialogue with EU Commissioner KADIS on 1 July

Report on the implementation of the MSP Directive in 2026

Seabasin cooperation: North Sea (GNSBI), Baltic, Mediterranean sea and Atlantic: political initiatives and projects

On-going revision by EU member States and public consultation: NL, FR, SP...

Need to coordinate objectives for 2030 and beyond: nature conservation and restoration, offshore renewables including grid, co-existence, maritime security

Revision of legislation => application of better regulation principles on evaluation, impact assessment, public consultation
